**FIADH VINEYARD
ANDERSON VALLEY
PINOT NOIR**

“Fiadh” is an Irish girl’s name meaning “wild” and “untamed,” very much like this small vineyard on a hillside in Anderson Valley. The 2021 vintage fermented spontaneously on native yeast with all whole clusters over twelve days and completed malolactic fermentation naturally in barrel, then aged eighteen months in French oak barrels, one-third new. The palate is a blend of forest notes – oak, black tea, mushrooms – and elegant perfumes – graphite, vanilla, and musk. Approachable now, the wine will not fully reveal its complexity until 2024 and should drink well for a decade.

Six barrels produced: 154 cases.
